Supplemental Web Survey Results





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ABOUT THIS REPORT

As part of its participation in The National Citizen Survey™ (The NCS), the Town of Hopkinton conducted a mailed survey of 1,200 residents. Surveys were mailed to randomly selected households in June of 2013 and data was collected through July 18, 2013. After the official data collection period was over and the data were reported (see the report, *The National Citizen Survey: Town of Hopkinton, MA 2013*), the Town made available the Web-based survey to its residents through a link on the Town's Web site. Visitors to the site were able to complete the survey during August and 295 surveys were received.

This report contains the results of this administration of the Web-based survey and have not been weighted to current population estimates of the Town.
