## Hopkinton Kindergarten Numbers (2013)


- 192 students enrolled

## Operating budget implications for tuition free Full-Day K

- Year 1
  - Additional 2.5 teachers (+150,000.)
  - Savings from half day bus run (-54,000.)
  - Loss of Tuition Revenue (+320,000.)
- Year 2
  - Chapter 70 aid (-120,000.)



## More benefits

Saving money spent on remediation and special education over the long term and increasing the opportunities for school success  Full-day kindergarten offers social, emotional and intellectual benefits to kindergarteners, giving them more time to focus and reflect on activities, and transition between them.
