November 14, 2014

- Notice of Intent to sell delivered to Selectmen.
- Chapter 61A offers the Board 120 days to take action on its right of first refusal.

• 203 Pond Street Public Hearing – 48 hours notice, according to OML.

Special Town Meeting key deadlines

- *Open Special Town Meeting warrant*: January 26, 2015 Publish to open the STM warrant with majority vote of the Selectmen.
- *Newspaper Advertisement:* February 1, 2015 (MetroWest Daily News):
 - 0 15 Days to publish in newspaper & close warrant:
 - 5 days to notify and publish in newspaper (February 1st MWDN);
 - Warrant closes on February 13th at 4:30 PM 10 business days after publication in local newspaper (Town Charter section 2-6(d)).
- Ballot Question & Warrant Articles: February 3, 2015 regular scheduled Selectmen Meeting
 - Selectmen vote to place 203 Pond Street as a ballot question and gives ballot question to Town Clerk in writing (35 days before Special Town Election);
 - 0 NOTE: Same meeting as opening warrant for Annual Town Meeting.
- *Sign STM warrant*: Proposed February 13th or Feb. 17th Board meeting to sign warrant.
- *Post STM Warrant:* February 17, 2015: Post Special Town Meeting warrant: 14 Days (Town Bylaw 47-1).
- *Voter Registration Deadline:* February 18, 2015: Last date to register to vote for Special Town Election (20 days, MGL chapter 51 sec 26-28).
- *Voter Registration Deadline:* February 20, 2015: Last date to register to vote for Special Town Meeting (10 days, MGL chapter 51 sec 26-28).

Tuesday, March 10 – Special Town Election

March 14, 2015 (Note: Saturday) - Town must exercise its Right of First Refusal

• 120 Days: town must act for right of first refusal at the ballot on debt exclusion.
