FY18 Budget Executive Summary December 8, 2016

1. Budget Overview

Elmwood School's projected enrollment for Fiscal Year (FY) 2018 is 499 students.

- In grade 2 a decrease of 14 students is projected.
- In grade 3 an increase of 24 students is projected.

The following class sizes are projected for FY18 based on the NESDEC revised November 2016 enrollment report:

- 11 Grade Two classrooms (decrease of 1) avg. 21.5 students per class
- 12 Grade Three classrooms (increase of 1) avg. 21.9 students per class

The FY18 Preliminary budget supports Elmwood School's efforts to further its progress in meeting Hopkinton Public School's Strategic Plan vision and values. Specifically, the budget supports progress toward meeting the following Strategic Plan objectives and priority initiatives:

- Il Aligned Curriculum,1A: Develop a dynamic and clearly articulated PK-12 curriculum with a focus on vertical alignment to the 2011 Massachusetts Curriculum Frameworks.
- III Effective Instruction, 2A: Educators deliver effective, evidence-based instruction to all students. 2B: Educators plan learning experiences that ensure opportunities for students to apply critical thinking, creativity, collaboration, and communication skills.
- IV Student Assessment, 2A: Use learning data to plan and adjust instruction and evaluate student learning. 3A: Educators support students in setting developmentally appropriate growth goals that encourage students to challenge their limits in a safe and supportive environment.

2. Personnel Summary

The FY18 Elmwood School Budget allows us to maintain current staffing for 23 classrooms across grades two and three with 3.5 co-taught classrooms. In previous budget cycles Elmwood received increases in staffing which include a shared Literacy Coach with Center School, a BCaBA, and an increase in Learning Specialists. These staffing increases allow Elmwood School to continue to support student needs appropriately. No new positions are requested in the FY18 budget.

3. Expense Summary

1. Elmwood staff conducted a careful examination of Supplies and Materials needs for FY18. As a result, line item reductions and increases in this area produced an overall FY18 budget total \$8,795 less than FY17. To be consistent with Center and Hopkins, consumable materials and office supplies have been moved into the General Supply line. This gives the appearance that we are requesting no specific-area instructional materials and a large increase in General Supplies. Included in the \$57,912 budget request is funding for Science materials and textbooks which are necessary to provide all students with an engaging, relevant, rigorous and coherent STE education. In addition, there is funding to continue with the research-based literacy program used in Kindergarten through grade 2 to teach critical foundational reading and writing skills.
