Newsweek Top Public High Schools

- Hopkinton was ranked #93
- Only 5 Massachusetts schools were ranked higher
- There are almost 30,000 public high schools in the US
- Rankings were based on several factors
 - Graduation rates, college enrollment rate, SAT/ACT scores, AP scores and participation, student to teacher ratios and dropout rates

2016 Niche Rankings

- Hopkinton was ranked at 12 as an entire district
 - HHS was ranked 14th best out of all public high schools in Massachusetts
 - HMS was 17th out of all public middle schools
 - Elmwood was 48th and Hopkins was 56th out of all public elementary schools
- Niche rankings are based on a variety of factors
 - We scored the highest in Academic Performance, Teacher Quality, and Health & Safety
 - We scored the lowest in Student Diversity

 - Only one school had larger average class sizes
 - Only three schools had more students taking AP exams
 - Hopkinton had the largest % of students taking AP exams
 - Hopkinton had the fourth best graduation rate
 - Hopkinton had the 6th lowest per-pupil spending



Top 2015 MCAS Performers Among 10th-Graders


- English Language Arts

 - 9th best performance in the state


