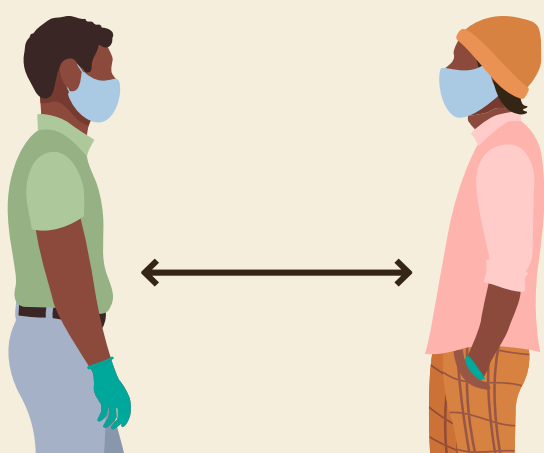


## FACE COVERINGS
